North American PRTR Data Users' Needs – Working Session: Feedback, p. 1

- ▶ It would be useful to create linkages between national and sub-national datasets
- ▶ More awareness of PRTR data is needed (of the public, but also among various government agencies, at local and regional levels)
- ▶ The quality and reliability of the data should be improved (through 3rd-party monitoring and verification of data, estimation methods, etc.)
- ▶ Internal facility reports, in addition to PRTR data, could benefit company/facility transparency. Facilities should be encouraged to report voluntarily if below PRTR reporting thresholds.

North American PRTR Data Users' Needs – Working Session: Feedback, p. 2

- ▶ Reporting thresholds and other criteria for reporting (such as excluded sectors and activities) should be reviewed and revised
- ▶ The integration of toxicity information with PRTR data would enhance the understanding of pollutant impacts (to address issues created by high thresholds, pollutant mixtures, and cumulative or chronic exposures)
- ▶ Need more details about cross-border transfers and the final disposition of those pollutants
- ▶ There should be a mechanism in the national PRTR data to allow for user feedback.
