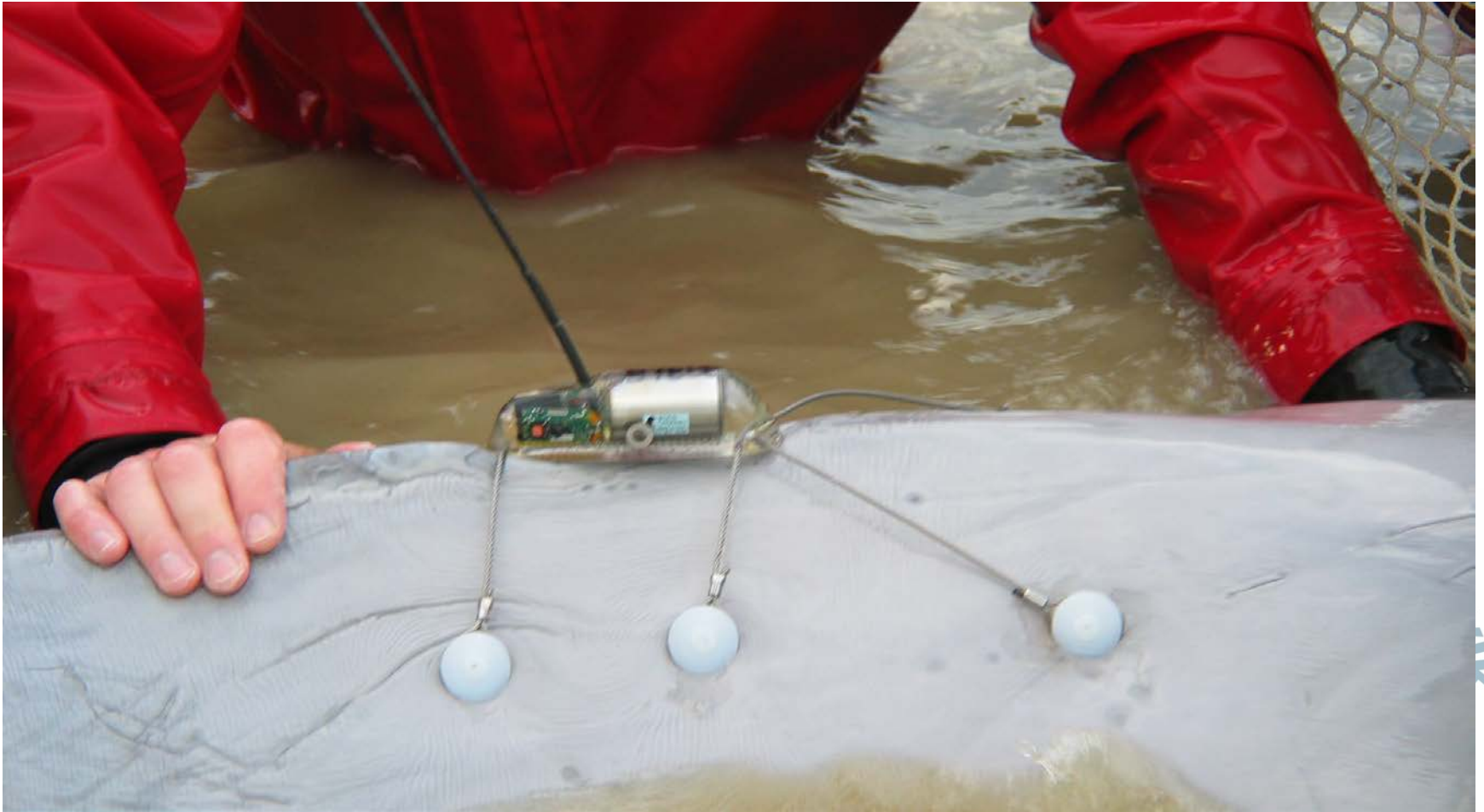




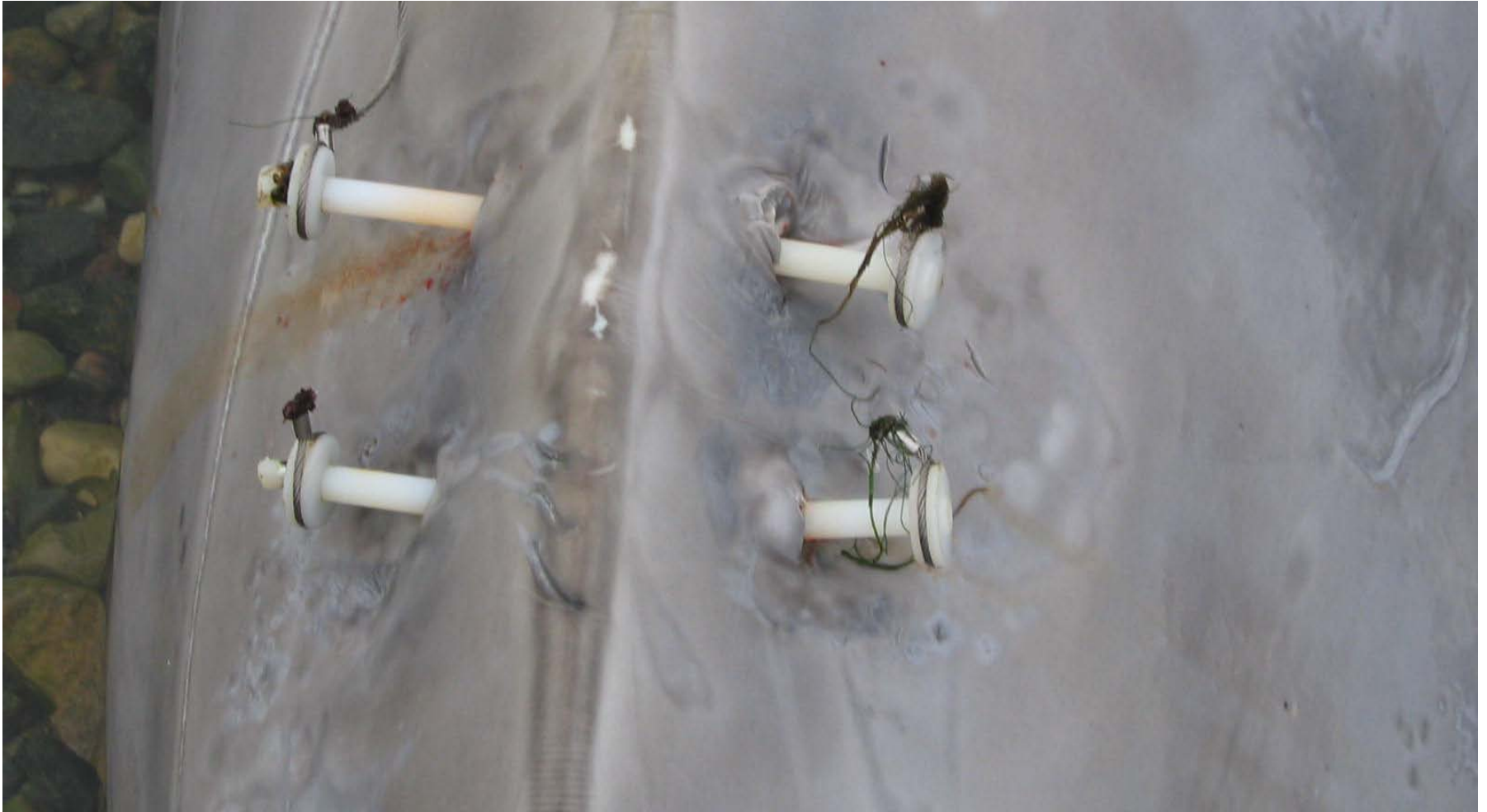
IQ: How to cross between the boundaries of people & animals
