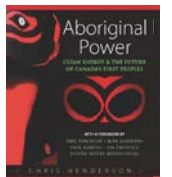
Impact of the Reservoir Associated with the Wuskwatin Generation Project, Manitoba

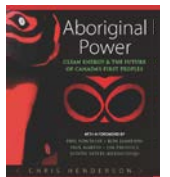






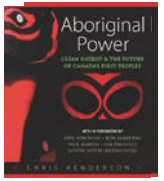
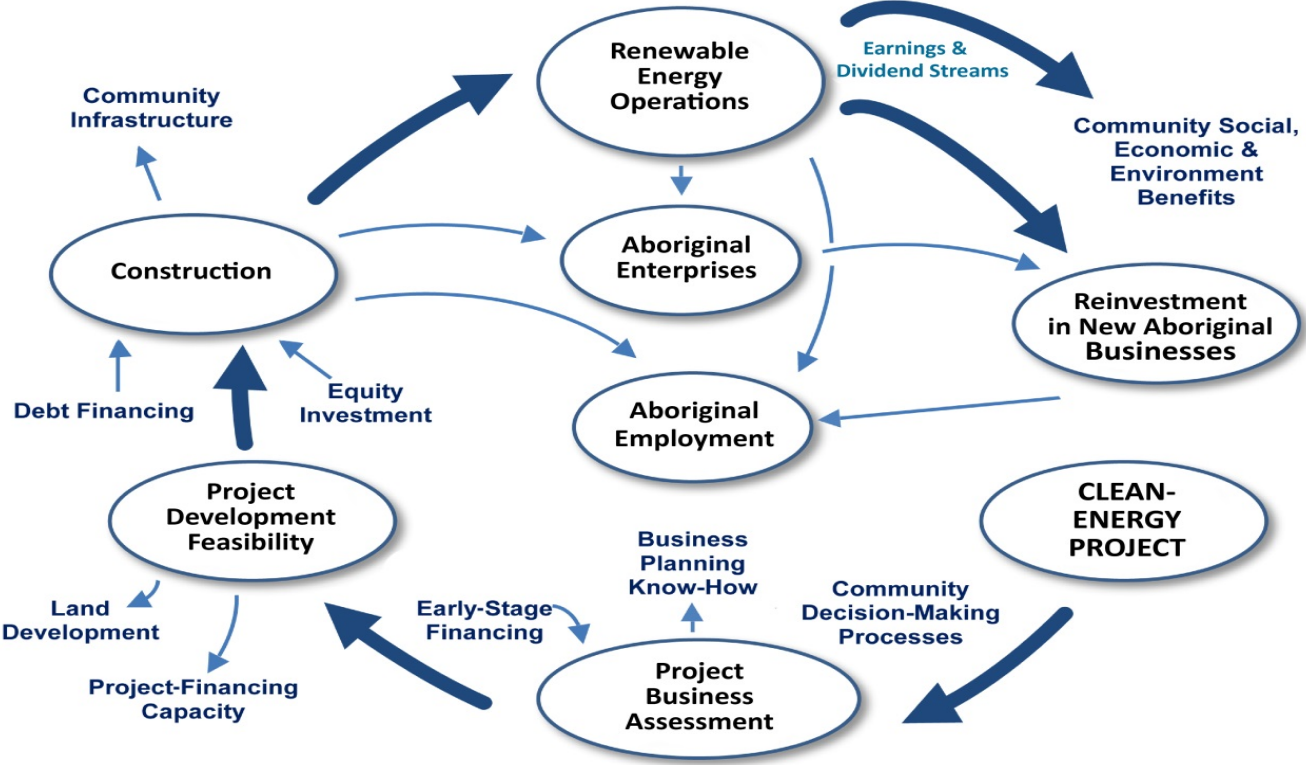




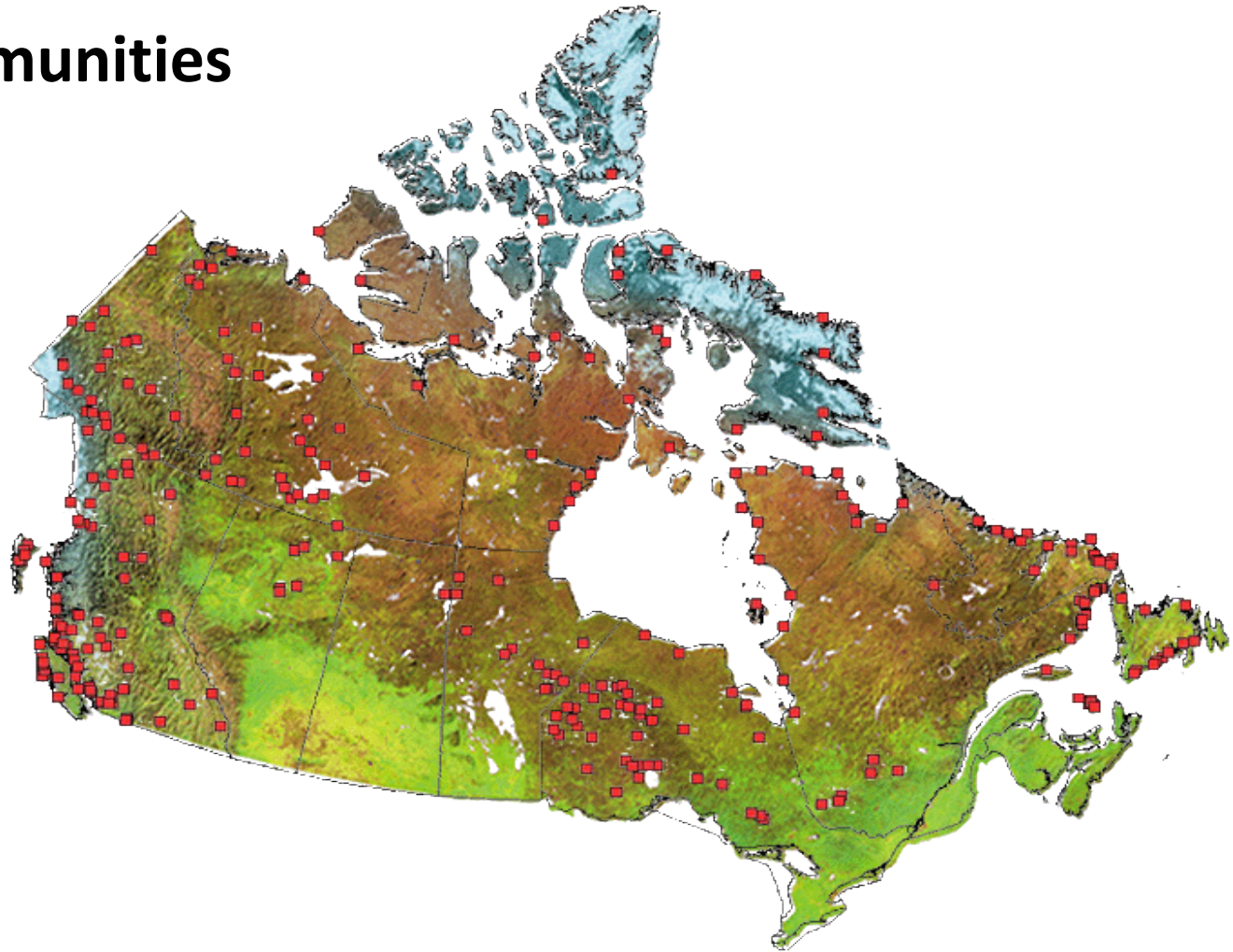


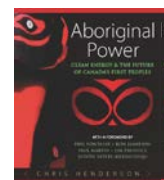
