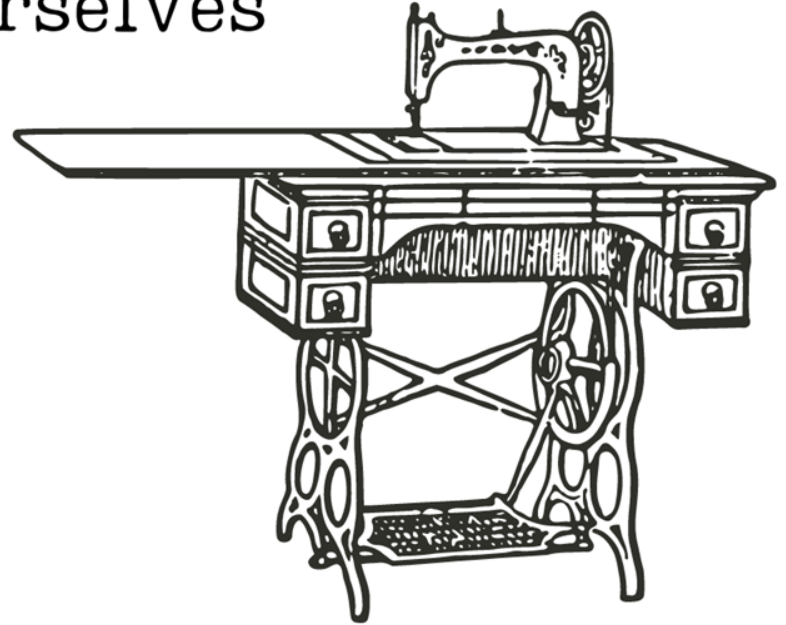

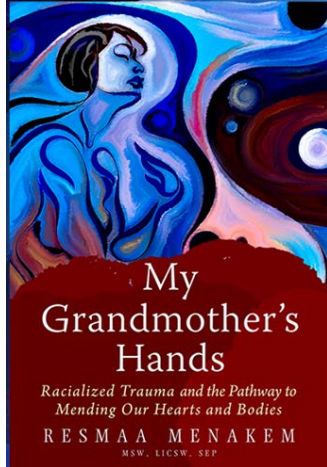
- Textile waste adds to growing climate crisis

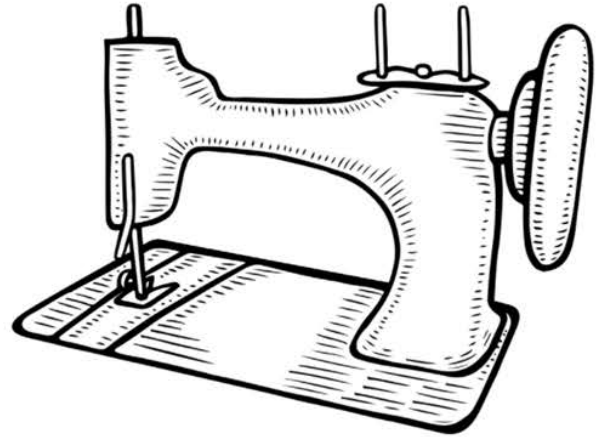
