Call for Expression of Interest

Background

The Commission for Environmental Cooperation (CEC) is an intergovernmental organization created by Canada, Mexico and the United States under the North American Agreement on Environmental Cooperation (NAAEC). The CEC was established to address regional environmental concerns, help prevent potential trade and environmental conflicts, and promote the effective enforcement of environmental law. The Agreement complements the environmental provisions of the North American Free Trade Agreement (NAFTA). For more information, visit <www.cec.org>.

The CEC is commencing new work in the area of food waste reduction and recovery, which includes its respective contribution to emissions causing climate change. A budget of C\$460,000 has been allocated to the CEC project entitled <u>North American Initiative on Food Waste Reduction and Recovery</u>. A significant portion of this budget will be allocated to one or more contracts with consultants to complete the tasks outlined in Section 2, below. It is anticipated that the contracted work will take place during January 2016 to April 2017.

Purpose

Input received from expressions of interest is intended to inform the CEC regarding the range of consulting expertise on food waste reduction and recovery that currently exists in North America and the extent to which such expertise exists in each of the three North American countries. The expression of interest does not represent a pre-qualification step for future contracting.

Consultants that provide an expression of interest will be notified of all CEC requests for contract services under this initiative as soon as they are made available.
