

# REPORT YOUR MONARCH AND MILKWEED SIGHTINGS

BECOME A COMMUNITY SCIENTIST BY REPORTING YOUR  
OBSERVATIONS TO JOURNEY NORTH IN THREE EASY STEPS

1. **Get outside!**

Look for monarch butterflies and milkweed, the monarch's host plant, where monarch eggs and caterpillars can be found.

2. **Make note of any sightings.**

Track any observations. Information you can include with your reports could be whether a monarch is visiting flowers or milkweed or laying eggs, but just knowing when and where you see a monarch adult, egg, or caterpillar is enough. Photos are appreciated, but not required.

3. **Submit your sightings, and you've contributed to monarch science!**
