Green Venture's EcoHouse is located in a 150-year-old home & welcomes 3,000-4,000 visitors every year.



### The Problem: Stormwater Runoff



- Infiltration is limited
- Runoff picks up pollutants and carries them to nearest water body



#### **Depave Hamilton**



Green Venture removed 93m<sup>2</sup> at a local elementary school, allowing 83m<sup>3</sup> (~83,000 litres) of stormwater to soak in every year.




#### **Depave Kingston**



Hearthmakers removed 350m<sup>2</sup> at a local elementary school, allowing 333m<sup>3</sup> (~333,000 litres) of stormwater to soak in every year.
