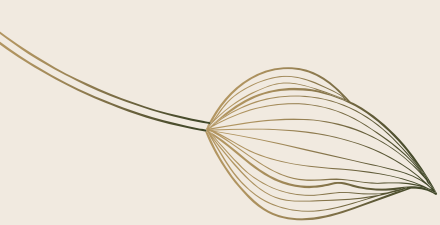
PFAS Pollution Research

- Persistent in the environment
