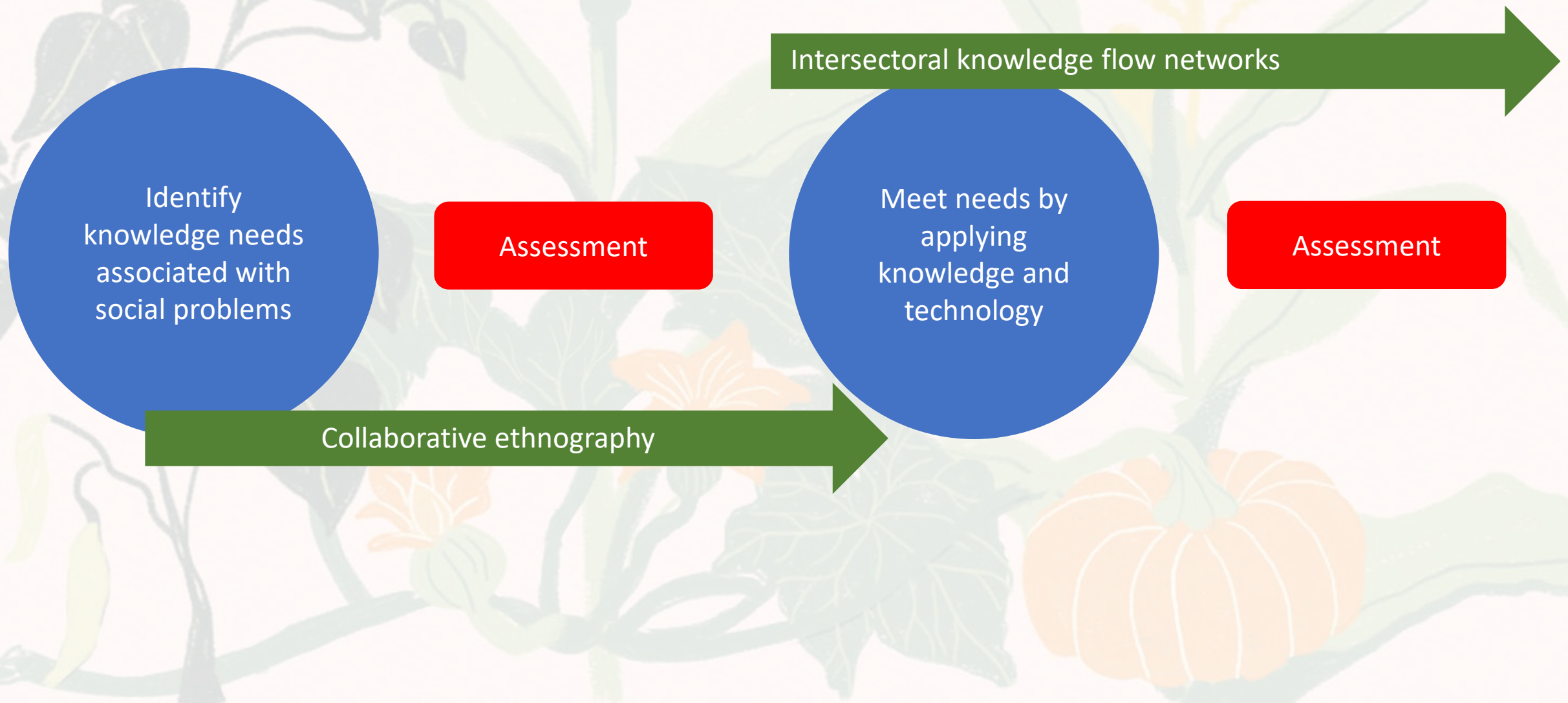
Knowledge management for local development

Revaluing
